### Questions for Chapter 4:

1. Can you think of a worship experience at St. Paul's or another church that engaged your heart, mind, soul, and strength?
  
2. If it's true that effective worship services help worshipers worship with all their hearts (the will), minds, souls (emotions), and strength (their physical bodies), where is SPLC strong? Where could we use some improvement? What ideas do you have that could help us?
  
3. On p. 81, the authors write: "Many people today think Contemporary is good and Traditional is bad. We don't agree. We think that contextual is best—worship that glorifies God and fits the context." In what ways does our worship expression fit our context? In what ways does it not?
  
4. In what ways can worship at SPLC be more celebrative?
  
5. Stetzer told the story of how one of the deacons had a mild heart attack during the contemporary worship service. What would give you a heart attack during worship? What gets your heart pumping?
  
6. Of the four preaching styles listed on p. 93-95, which do you think would be a good fit for our context?
