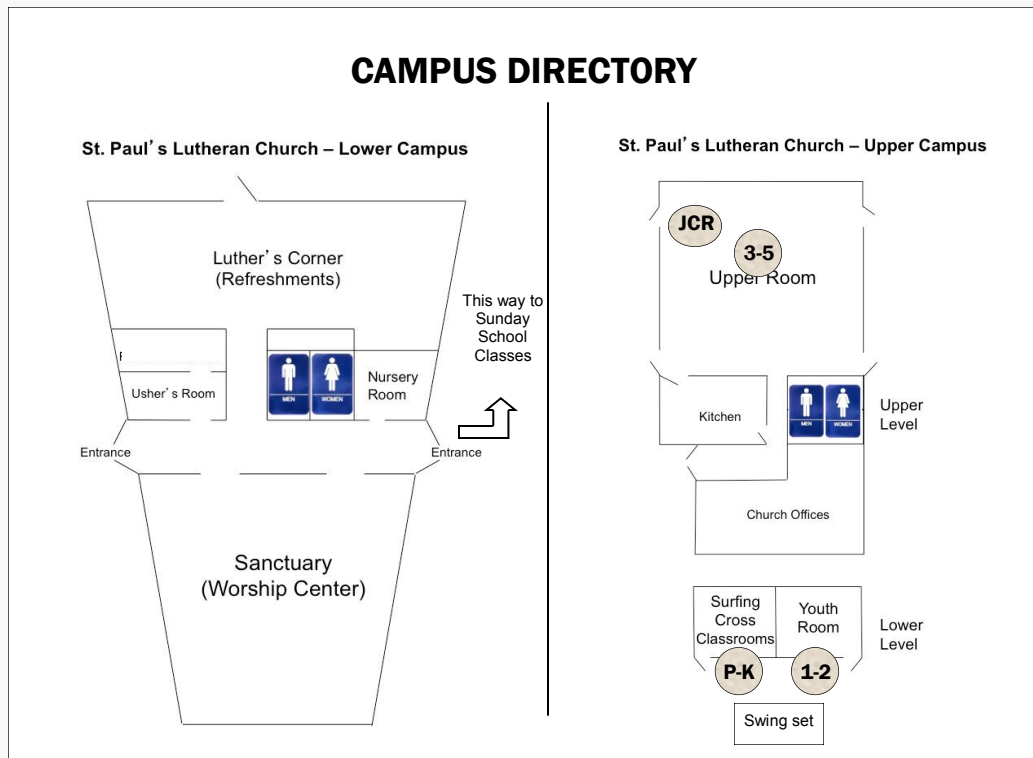

Today's Worship

Worship is our response to the divine initiative. It is one attempt as a community to respond to His command to love Him with all of our heart, soul, mind, and strength (Lev. 19:18; Luke 10:27). We do this not in order that God loves us, but because God first loved us (1 John 4:19). The order of worship is on the flap/bookmarker. Prayer Requests for inclusion in today's service may be written on the blue cards found in the pews. Please hand them to the outside aisles for pick up during the Hymn of the Day.

New to St. Paul's?

1. Relax. Make yourself at home. Feel free to participate as much or as little as you feel comfortable. No matter where you are on your spiritual journey, we're glad you're here. A campus directory can be found on the back of this program to help you find your way around.

2. What about my kids? We believe that children are the church, not just the future of the church. Thus, your kids are more than welcomed to stay through the entire service. But here are some options:

•**Nursery:** The last two rows on the left side of the worship center are the closest to the nursery (see directory). They are reserved for families with little children. The nursery is provided for those with children 3 years old and under.

•**Children's Messages** are offered every Sunday at the 9 AM service for kids preschool through 5th grade. Kids are then released to go with their leaders for Children's Ministry, or they can stay in worship with you. (See the back page for ministry leaders and locations.) They return for communion to receive a blessing then rejoin parents after the service. Parents are welcomed to accompany their kids for both if they're a little shy the first few times.

3. Fill out your Communication Card. To get connected and take the next steps in your spiritual journey, please fill out as much information as you feel comfortable sharing on your Communication Card. Then you can drop it in the offering plate as it is passed toward the end of the service.

4. Pick up your gift. If this is your first time at St. Paul's, please take the book, *How Good Is Good Enough?* as a gift. Simply drop off your Communication Card in the offering plate, then pick up your copy on your way out. It's on the table near the parking lot exit. (You are welcomed to give at the time of the offering, but please do not feel obligated.)
